



**MODULE TITLE:** Caring for Children with an Inherited Metabolic Disorder

### Module Description:

This exciting and innovative module offers a unique opportunity to registered nurses and healthcare practitioners working in the field of child and adolescent/adult Inherited Metabolic Disorders (IMD). Practitioners, based either in a hospital or community setting, will gain insight and a deeper understanding of inherited metabolic disorders, including topics such as underlying pathology, treatment modalities, and current research.

### Learning Outcomes:

- describe the care and management of individuals with inherited metabolic disorders
- evaluate the psychosocial needs of children and families with inherited metabolic disorders
- discuss the contribution of the multidisciplinary team to the care of individuals with inherited metabolic disorders
- explain the provision of health education appropriate to the needs of patients and their families
