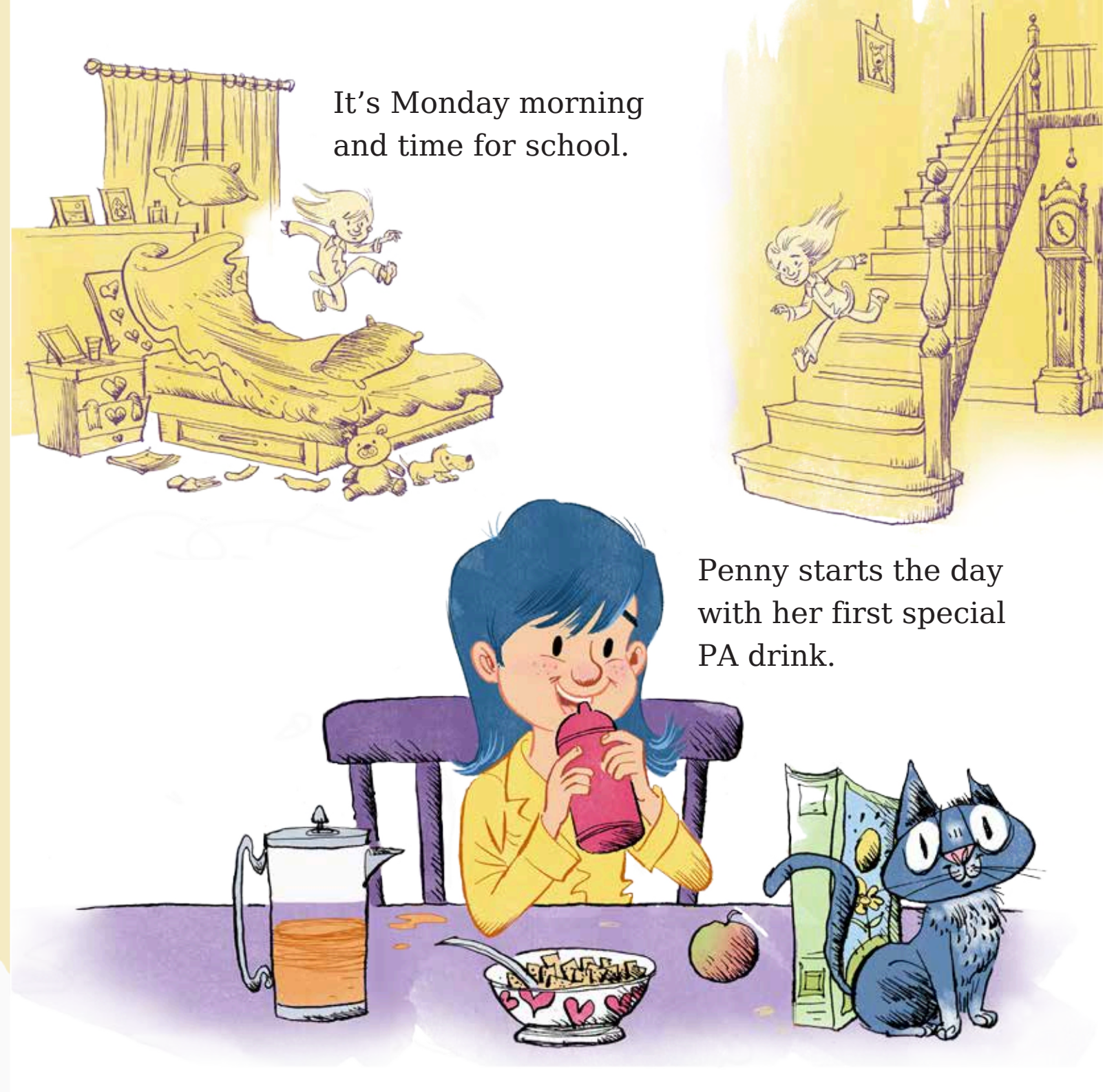

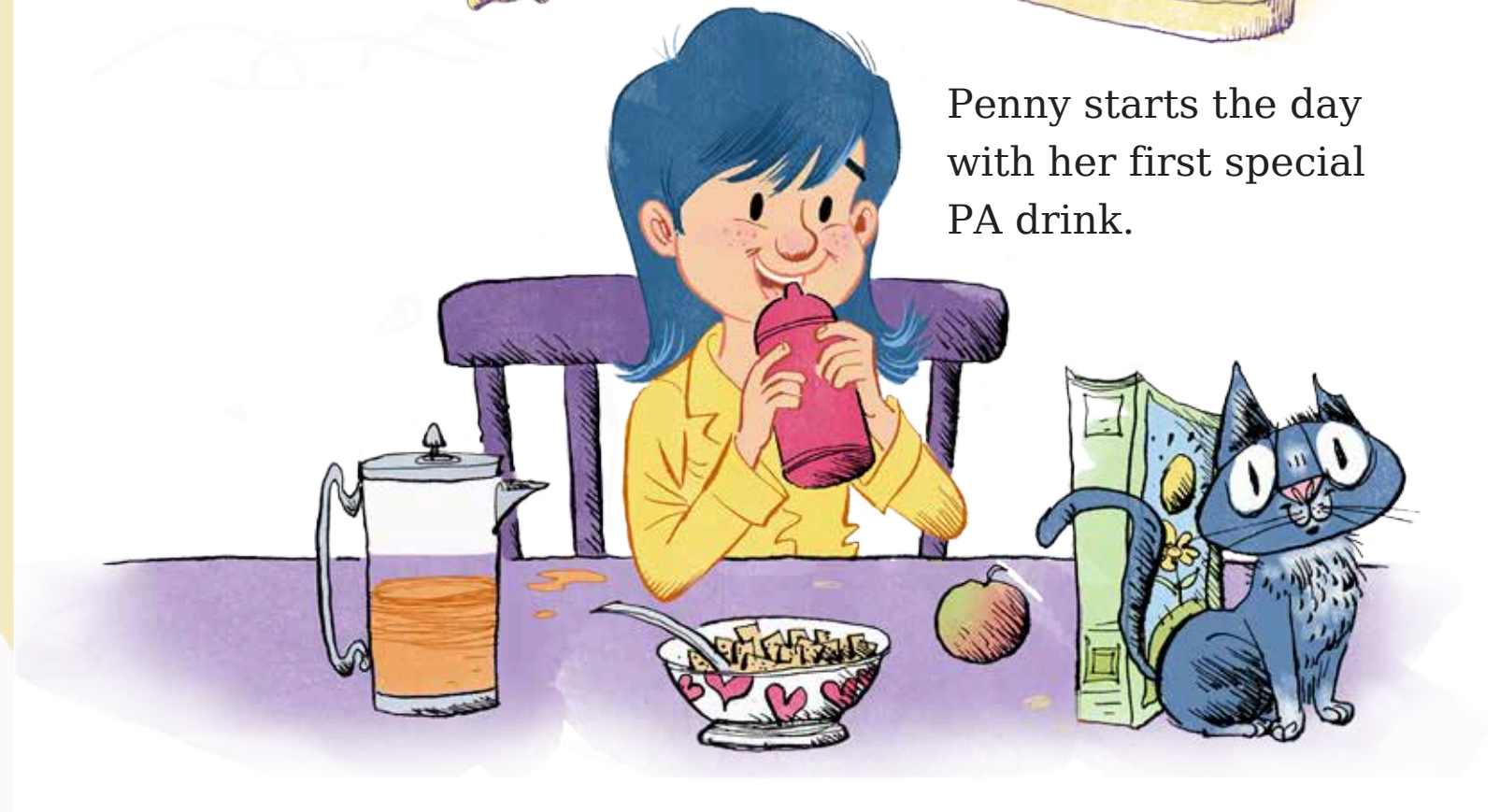




This is Paul and Penny.
They have PA just like you.

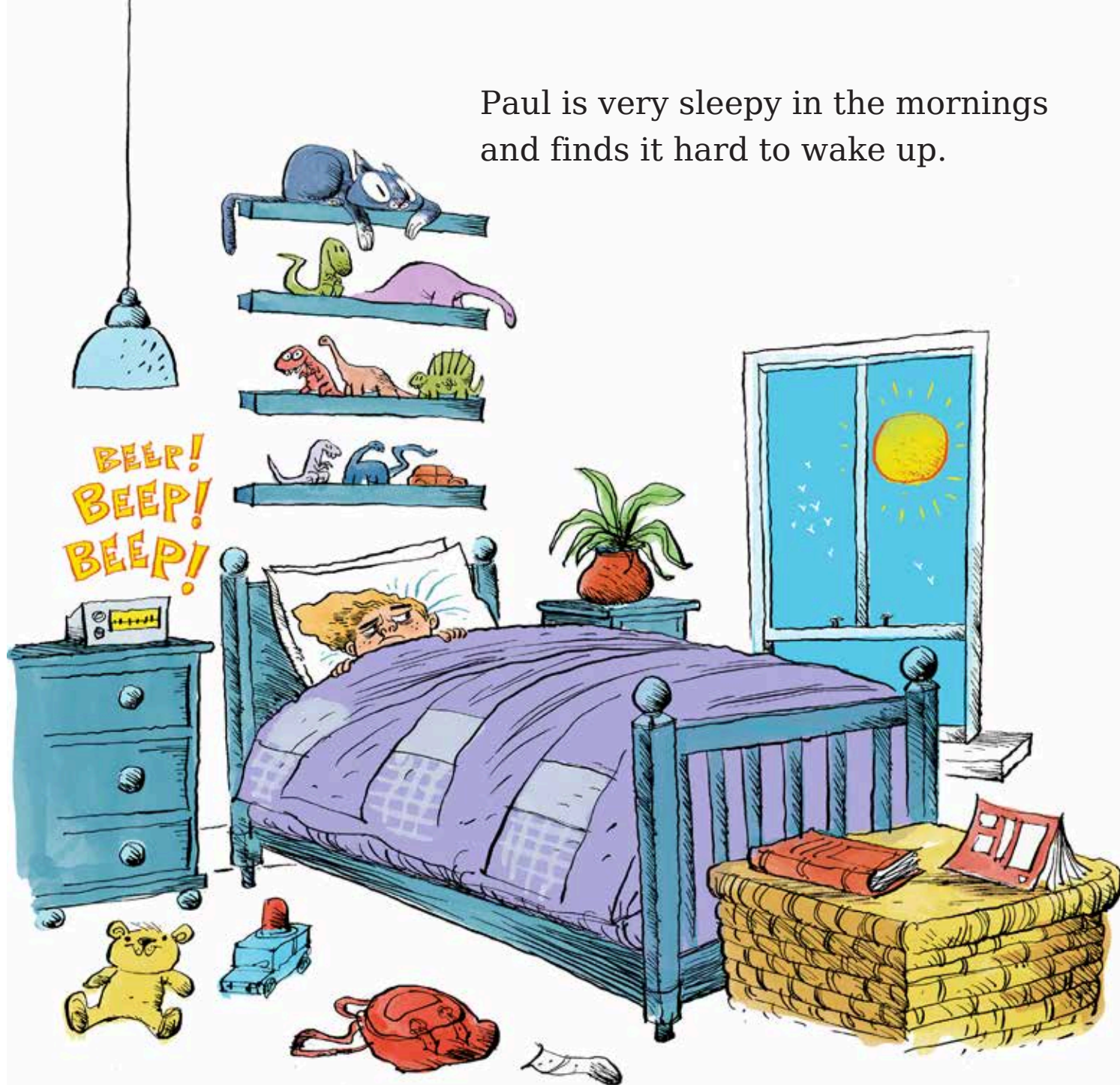


It's Monday morning

Paul forgets to take his drink which makes him tired and late for school.

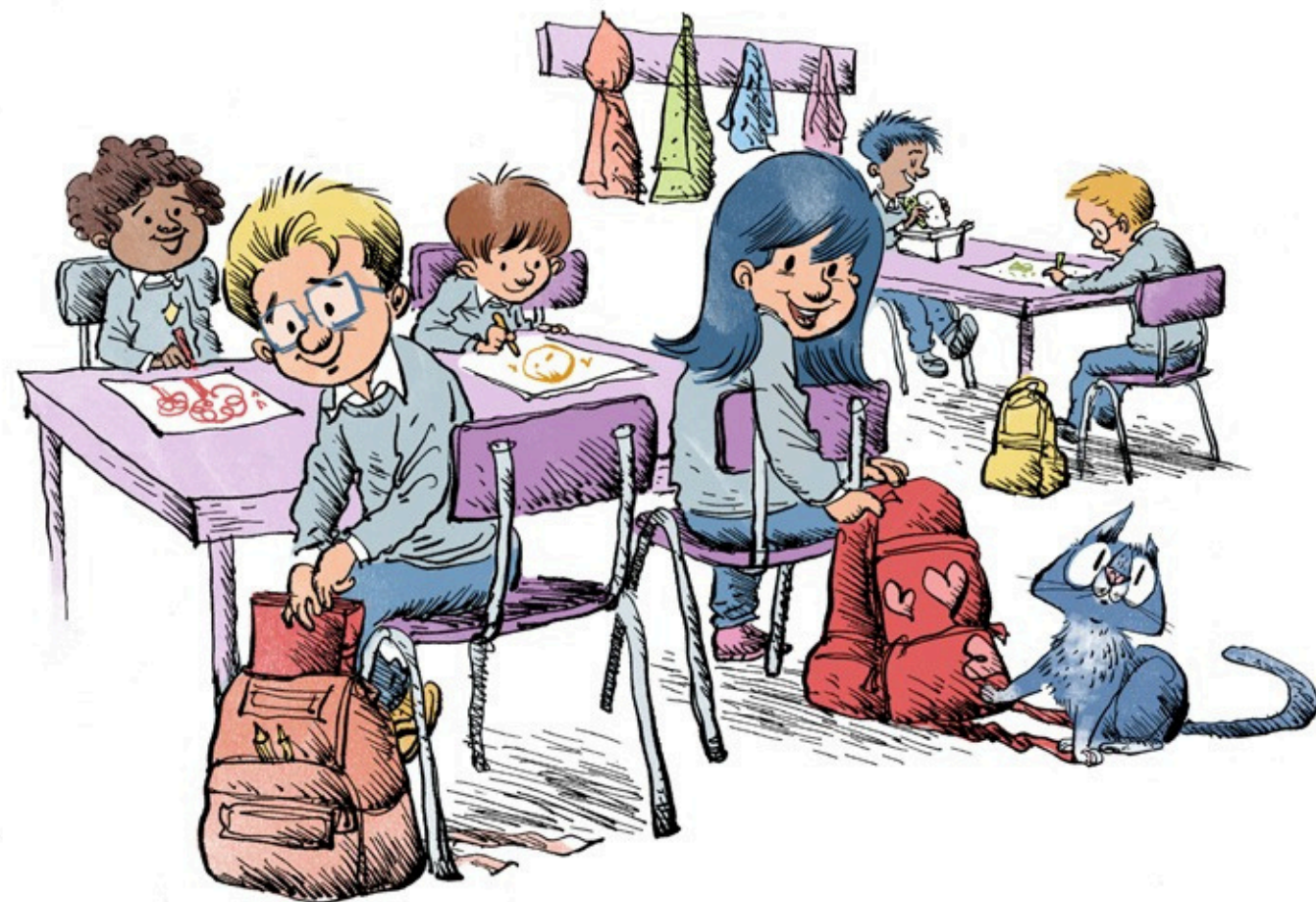

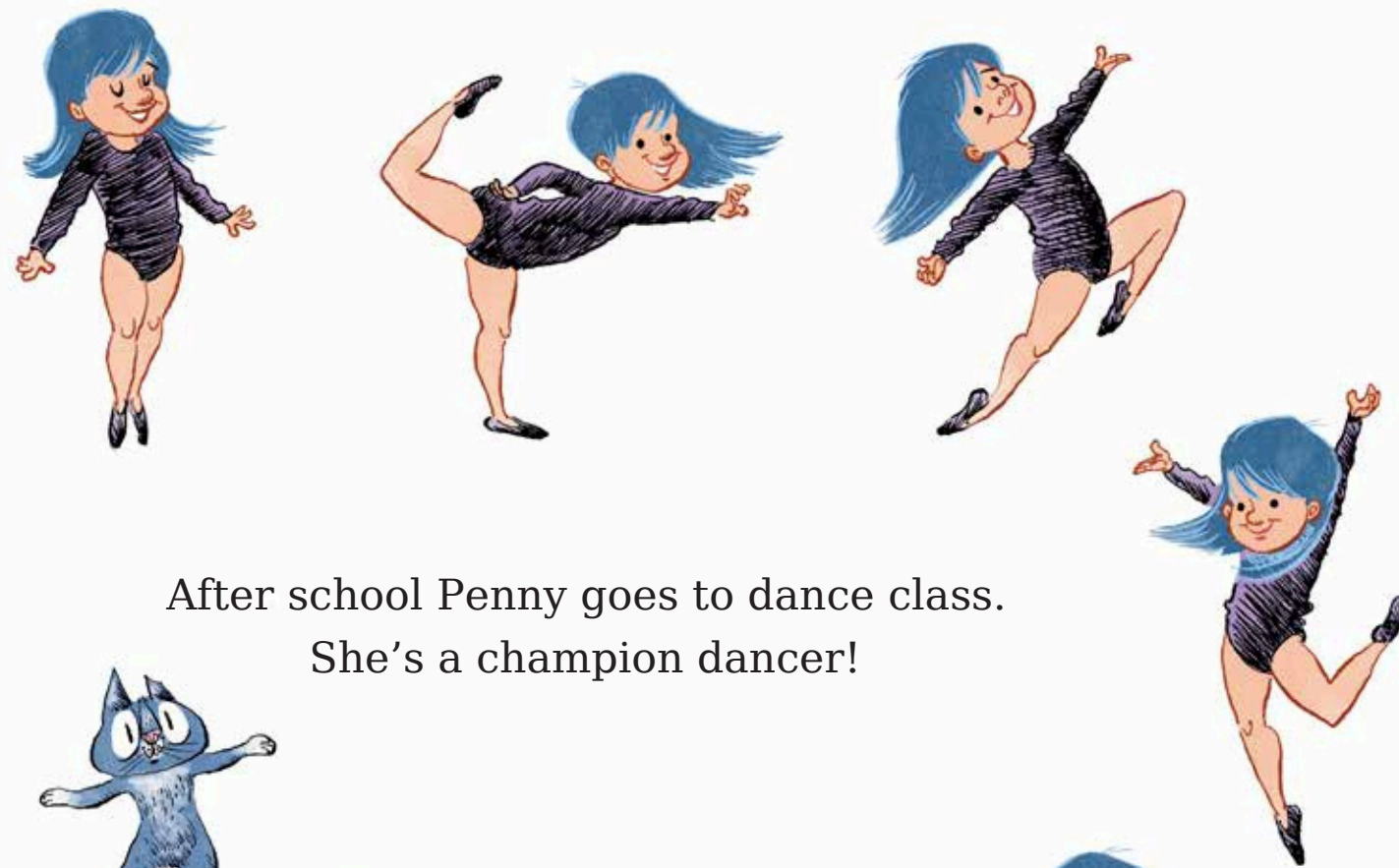

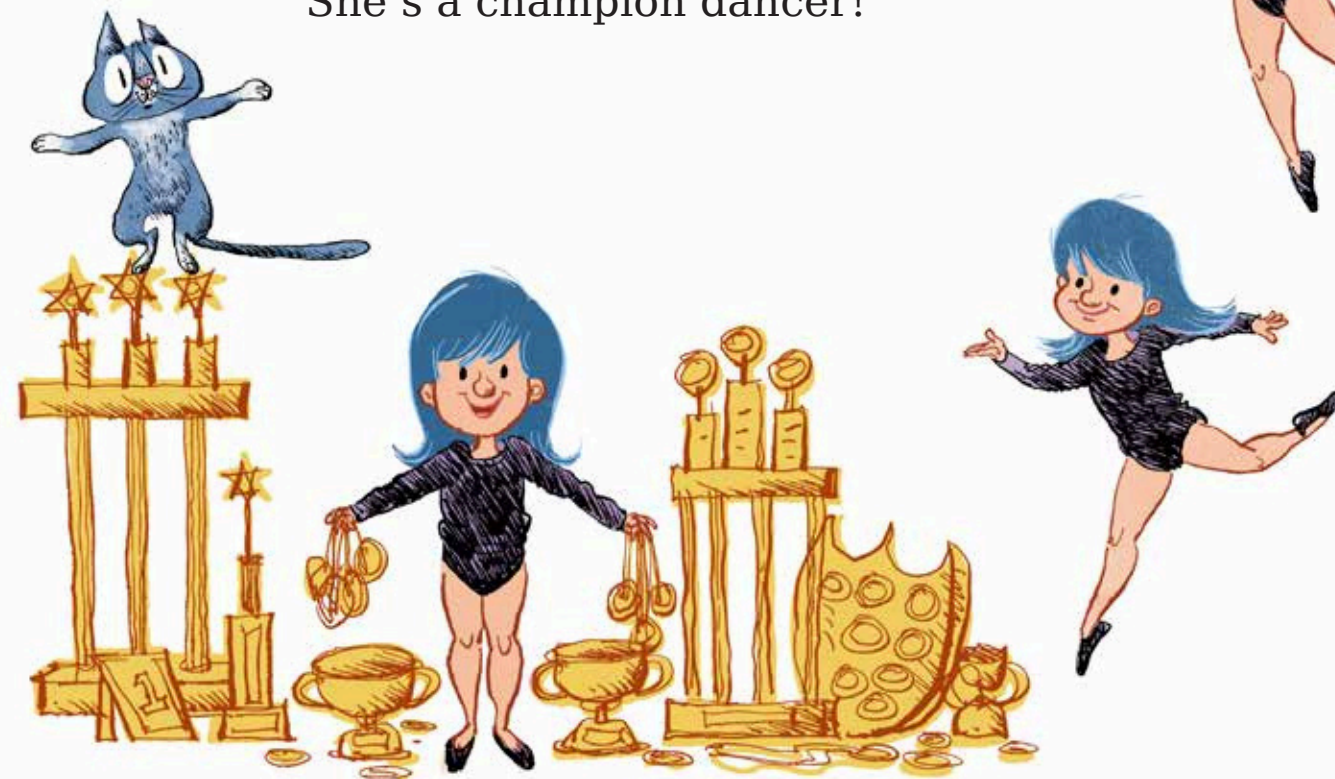
Penny gets to school early and when the bell rings it's time for her second PA drink.



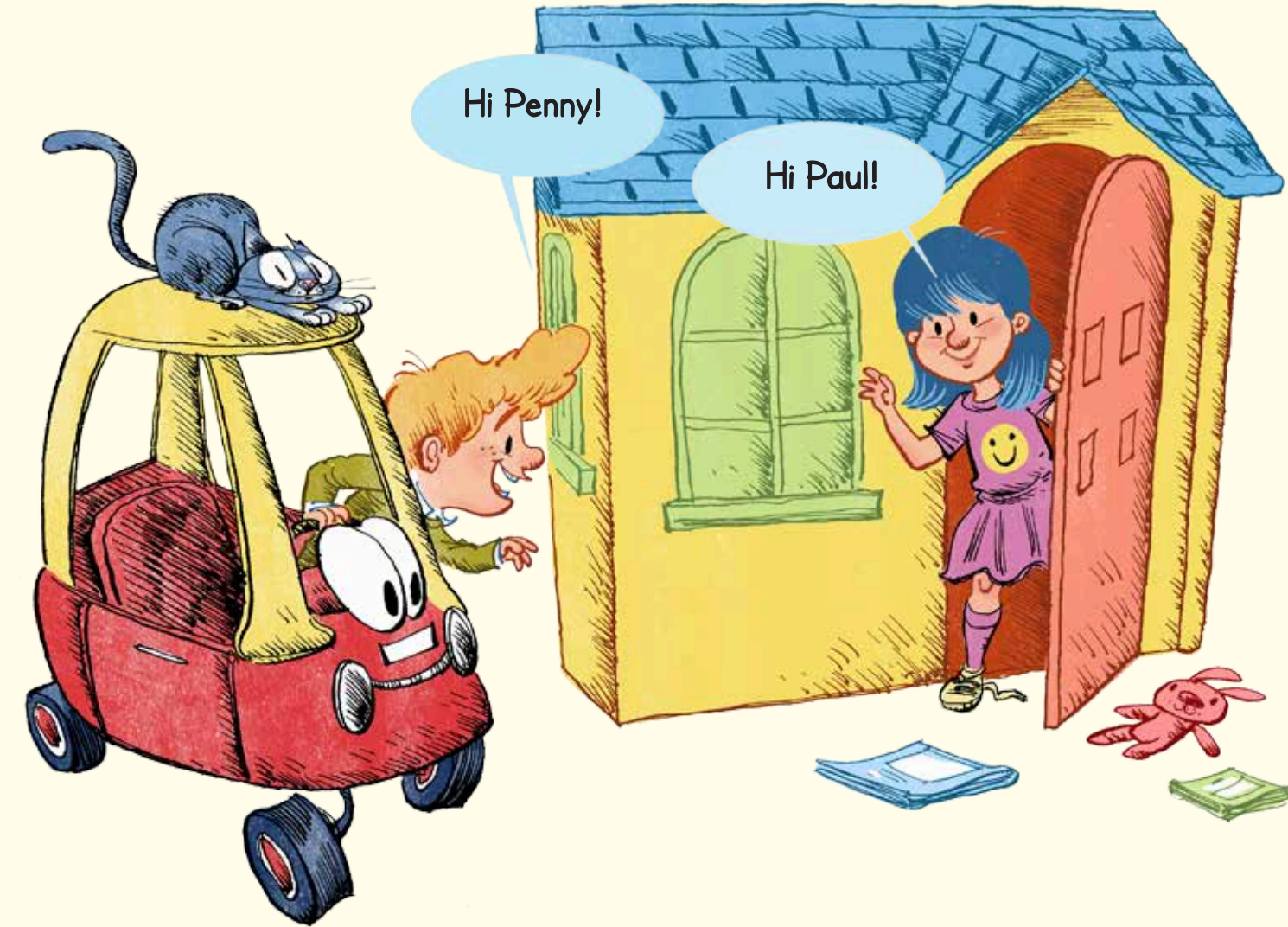
Paul is so tired he sleeps through lunchbreak!

meet at the PA Clinic in Temple Street Hospital



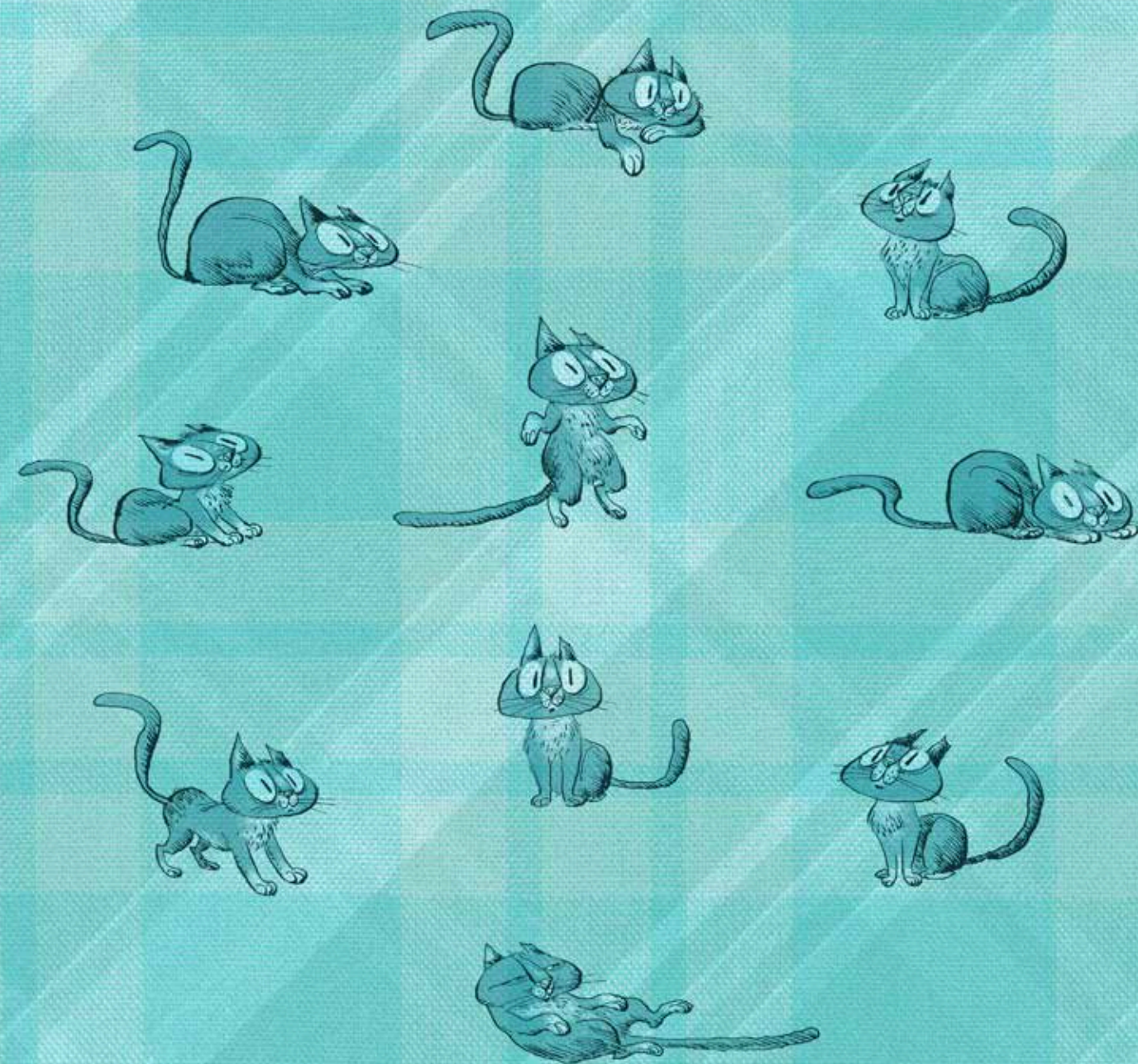




Penny gives Paul a star for his chart and he never forgets to take his PA drink again. Now he has loads of energy when he wakes up in the morning.
